- provide each parent information about the performance of their child on the state assessment in at least math and language arts through Confidential Student Reports from the state, Skyward Family Access, report cards, and progress reports.
- provide instructional materials and strategies to help parents improve their child's academic achievement and foster parental involvement by hosting parent orientation, family fun nights, book fairs, counselor meetings with parents, teacher conferences, PTO events.
