Our school hosts a variety of Parent Engagement activities throughout the year, developed in collaboration with our parents. These events are designed to strengthen our relationship with the school community, and we encourage you to participate. Additionally, we take pride in our dedicated teachers. As per federal guidelines, you have the right to request information about their education and qualifications, including:

- Whether the teacher has met state qualifications for the grade levels and subject areas in which they provide instruction.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or provisional status that waives state qualifications.
- The baccalaureate degrees earned by the teacher, including their field of study and any additional certifications.
- Information about paraprofessionals providing services to your child and their qualifications.
