- 1) Staff Questions to Committee
 - a) Student Devices – teachers are having issues with students bringing electronic devices to class that are not fully charged or with a dead battery after being utilized in previous classes. Teachers should allow students to charge devices in class and we should look for ways to provide charging opportunities for students in classrooms. The CEIC committee would like to look at the addition of statements in the 2022/23 Student Code of Conduct that address the students' responsibility to bring their fully charged electronic device to school each day, and the consequences of repeatedly forgetting their electronic device.
 - b) Tribe Time – students not scheduled in a HB454 Remediation class should be provided the opportunity to work on classwork in their scheduled class during Tribe Time.
 - c) Advanced Academics – Mrs. Harris would like to see the creation of a monthly meeting between instructional leads and curriculum coordinators to review and discuss the state of academics at WHS.
