Welcome and Updates - Dr. Averett updated the committee on the current construction of Wilemon Steam Academy, ground-breaking for Waxahachie Creek High School Dec. 3rd, BLK architecture is meeting with parents, students and teachers to plan school themes and mascot. Two Town Hall meetings are upcomings to start the discussion of rezoning due to the second comprehensive high school. Safety and security of schools will also be discussed. Dr. Averett reported that 100% of classroom walks showed the use of high quality instructional materials are being used. SBOE should be voting this week to approve HQIM. Dr. Hollingsworth will be leaving at the end of the semester to assume his new position as Superintendent of Eagle Mountain-Saginaw school district. The School Board will name an interim WISD Superintendent at a called meeting December 3, 2024.

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes - Mrs. Mott asked the committee to read over the minutes from the previous meeting. Jacob Perry made a motion to approve, Mrs. O'Neil seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Federal Programs Overview - Ms. Kubin explained the intent and purpose of federal Title I, II, III & IV funds and gave examples of expenditures and federal requirements for the use of federal funds.

Comprehensive Needs Assessment - Ms. Kubin explained the process and purpose of the CNA. Every committee member will need to serve on a subcommittee in the spring of 2025 to plan for the 25-26 school year.

District Improvement Plan Evaluation - Ms. Kubin went over the process for quarterly evaluations and the relationship to the district Scorecard. The district plan is currently updated.

Title Funds Budget Expenditures Updates - Ms. Kubin gave current percentages of title funds spent thus for this grant year and opened the meeting for discussion.

2025-2026 School Calendar Development - Mrs. Mott went over general parameters for calendar development. She had the committee break up into small groups and list

three 'likes' and two things suggested for change. Each group took turns and shared their findings. Mott will gather information from all the group posters and consolidate the information to review at the next meeting. She asked the committee members to go back to their respective campuses and gather information about what staff likes and dislikes. At the next DEIC meeting on January 14, 2025, the committee will be tasked with proposing a calendar to take to the school board for approval.
