

# District Education Improvement Committee

September 13, 2023

The meeting opened at 4:30 p.m. with Superintendent Dr. Jerry Hollingsworth welcoming everyone and thanking them for serving on the committee. He asked everyone to introduce themselves, give their role on the committee, and share one thing they are excited about.

He then highlighted the district's vision and core values: the choices offered, collaboration efforts, programs and processes to develop an environment of belonging, and developing community relationships. He shared the district's current enrollment and demographics.

Assistant Superintendent Dr. David Averett gave an update on the Balanced Scorecard, *Priority 1.3 Every graduate is college, career, or military ready, and CCMR numbers increase year over year*. He specifically addressed the issue with the large jump in the percentage needed for the CCMR requirement. He used graphs and charts to show Waxahachie's graduates meeting the criteria, the A-F distributions for schools based on previous requirement and the impact of released changes on the A-F distributions.

Federal Programs Director Christi Kubin reviewed Title Funds I-IV and how those funds are used as well as which schools receive Title Funds. She then explained Title I requirements which include a Parental Involvement Policy, a District Needs Assessment, and a District Improvement Plan. She distributed copies of the proposed Parental Involvement Policy for the committee to review. Tonya Harris made a motion to approve the Policy and Jessica Chambliss seconded. The plan was approved with no opposition. Mrs. Kubin then explained how District Improvement Plan and Balanced Scorecard mirror each other with the Balanced Scorecard being a simpler tool. In addition, all WISD campuses must have a Campus Improvement Plan. The District Improvement Plan and all Campus Improvement Plans will be presented to the School Board for approval at the October meeting.

Assistant Superintendent Lisa Mott briefly spoke to the committee regarding the process of creating the 2024-25 academic calendar. She gave the group an assignment for representatives to gather feedback from their campus or department as far as likes and dislikes of the current 2023-24 academic calendar.

The DEIC will meet again on November 30 to review the data.

The meeting was adjourned by Mrs. Mott at approximately 5:50 p.m.
















