1. Welcome - Good Things

• Mr. Zandt expressed to the committee that it was a couple of days before Thanksgiving, so it has been a great week. Staff who have taught at other campuses know how difficult the October to November stretch is.

2. Campus Improvement Plan November Review

- Mr. Zandt reviewed priority one, which was related to student growth. A
 majority of the conversation was about utilizing a study hall during advisory.
 Dr. Lester suggested using the cafeteria as a study hall area. Mr. Zandt
 included that we could use the cafeteria as a staging area for the students who
 failed a class, and that would allow teachers in advisory to cover the tutoring
 for students who wanted it, and that would allow for quiet tutoring rooms.
- AM Tutoring is an idea, but the bus situation with it coming so late would be an issue.
- CCMR strategy and implementing College Bridge as a tool for students struggling with TSIA will benefit Global towards every student gaining a point for CCMR.

3. District Climate Survey Data

- a. I enjoy my work 97%
- b. I am proud to work for my district 83%
- c. I know how my work aligns with the overall goals of my campus & district 87%
- d. My direct supervisor respects me 84%
- e. I feel comfortable providing feedback to supervisors -77%
- f. My leaders communicate well 77%
- g. I receive recognition for good work 67%

h. I believe my district has a good culture - 67%

- Survey results were from last spring but never shared. Mr. Zandt mentioned that he hopes to improve communication, recognition, and providing feedback to supervisors, and the district has a good culture.
- Mr. Zandt reiterated that having a superintendent who believes in the ECHS campus concept is a positive. Dr. Hollingsworth has always been open about the good of having Global in Waxahachie ISD. Ms. Tiki Smith mentioned that the district and Ms. Jenny Bridges share our social media on their pages, which shows they care about Global. That has been an improvement.
- Mr. Zandt told the committee that the office staff's goal is to ensure an open and welcoming campus for anyone who enters the building. We want to be the friendliest campus in the district. He believes we are already there. Kudos to the office staff!

4. Any Concerns?

- Mr. Coker talked about the difficulty of changing the admin every few years.
 Mr. Zandt stated that it is good to have some stability with the cabinet and that he has a great working relationship with them and doesn't see it changing.
