Campus Improvement:

If a team qualifies for the State competition and chooses to go, the tournament will take place in Arlington. Globals take place out of state (Missouri) and while the district is able to offer some support, teams who qualify for Globals and want to go must be willing to do some fundraising or pay for part of the expenses themselves.
- I am reaching out to other districts in our region to find out how they support teachers who volunteer as team managers to see if there are things we could implement here as well.
