Kindergarten had concerns about the amount of tests that have been given. Curriculum was contacted about this concern. They answered that MAP testing was a district diagnostic test (new this year), TEXAS test (state mandate), and beginning of the year testing as in previous year. The state testing is a quick screener that all students must take but shouldn't take too long to assess.

Some were concerned that more students would be returning/larger class sizes and how would we ensure social distancing. We will continue to follow district guidelines and encourage all grade levels to wear masks/shields.

Some are having Wi-Fi connectivity issues on campus. Encouraged all to do technology tickets when they have any technology issues.

Some "new building" concerns came up. Members were encouraged to add to our campus Google Doc if they had any further campus/building concerns or questions.

Some were having trouble with Promethean boards. Technology is aware and will be coming to fix those issues.

Will Special education teachers continue to be required to do online and in person teaching? Some are using after-school hours to do zoom meetings and push out SeeSaw info to parents/students since they are limited during the school day and don't seem to have enough

time during the day for both. *This concern was sent to DEIC and addressed by the Special Education department.
