1. District Balanced Score Card (BSC)
 - a) Driving force for campus and Campus Education Improvement Committee (CEIC) meetings.
 - b) Current Campus Improvement Plan (CIP), and District Improvement Plan (DIP) are extensive (80+ pages).
 - c) The new scorecard, BCS, will focus on key needs for WISD and WHS for long-term planning.
 - d) CEIC will utilize the District BSC to meet the needs of WHS.
2. Implement District Core Values
 - a. How are we going to implement the WISD Vision and Core Values into WHS?
 - b. As a team, we will begin to look at implementing our core values campus-wide and in our classrooms.
 - c. CEIC will work on the Campus Improvement Plan (CIP) and the Campus Needs Assessment (CNA) for 22/23 SY in future meetings.
3. Testing
 - a. Common Assessments – What value do common assessments have?
 - b. Does the WHS team understand the difference between formative and summative assessments?
 - c. Do we need to schedule professional development covering assessments and utilizing assessment data?
 - d. MAP Testing will not go away. Future EOC exams will be modeled to resemble MAP testing.

 - a. As part of Professional Learning Communities (PLC) at WISD, our teachers will need to select essential standards for data reporting on campus scorecards.
